10.4 Adoption of Resolution #19 1920 to Enter Into an Agreement with Sierra School Equipment Company for Modular Office Furniture Using Arvin Piggyback Bid #2018-19-001

<u>BACKGROUND INFORMATION</u>: The district suffered damage to its facilities as a result of two earthquakes in July 2019. After assessing damages and determining the extent of repair necessary, a decision was made to relocate Richmond Elementary School to the district's site at 348 Rowe Street, formerly Vieweg Elementary. In order for the Richmond staff and students to relocate to the Vieweg location, it was necessary for the Curriculum & Instruction (C&I) staff to relocate to the Sierra Vista Education Center (SVEC). Certain improvements are necessary at the SVEC in order to accommodate requirements of the C&I staff.

<u>CURRENT CONSIDERATIONS</u>: Pursuant to Public Contract Code sections 10290 et seq. and 10298 et seq., the governing board of a school district may, without competitive bidding, contract with suppliers that have been awarded contracts, master agreements, multiple award schedules, cooperative agreements, or other types of agreements with state agencies that leverage the state's buying power, for acquisitions authorized under specified sections of the California Public Contract Code.

District staff, in consultation with legal counsel, obtained and reviewed a proposal by Sierra School Equipment Company (SSEC) for modular furniture and temporary, "demountable" wall systems for the C&I Room "A" at the SVEC. Currently there are 5 staff members sharing the room, with no individual space or wall systems. This has created a very loud and disruptive work environment. The proposed furniture will provide a level of privacy and sound-proofing in the room, and will meet the requirement of the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) that all investments in office furniture or office improvements be temporary in nature.

Approval of the resolution will enable the district to contract with SSEC pursuant to the terms of the Arvin Piggyback Bid #2018-19-001 as permitted by the California Public Contract code.

<u>FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS</u>: The cost for the modular office furniture and wall systems is \$160,664.85. It is anticipated that 75% of this funding will be reimbursed by Cal OES. The remaining 25% will come from Fund 01 – General Fund.

<u>SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION</u>: It is the superintendent's recommendation that the board adopt Resolution #19 1920 to approve an agreement with Sierra School Equipment company using Arvin Piggyback Bid #2018-19-001.

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN AGREEMENT WITH SIERRA SCHOOL EQUIPMENT COMPANY USING ARVIN PIGGYBACK BID #2018-19-001 RESOLUTION #19 1920

WHEREAS, the governing board of a school district under Public Contract Code sections 10290 et seq. and 10298 et seq. may, without competitive bidding, contract with suppliers that have been awarded contracts, master agreements, multiple award schedules, cooperative agreements or other types of agreements, including agreements with entities outside the state or other agreements that leverage the state's buying power, for acquisitions authorized under Chapter 2 (commencing with Section 10290) and Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 12100) of the Public Contract Code; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of Education (the "Board") of the Sierra Sands Unified School District (the "District") has determined that a true and very real need exists for modular office furniture for the Sierra Vista Center Room A (the "Goods and Services"); and

WHEREAS, the District's Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the District to authorize the procurement of the modular office furniture necessary from Sierra School Equipment through the Arvin Piggyback Bid #2018-19-001; and

WHEREAS, Sierra School Equipment Company provided the attached proposal that sets forth the specific services that the District will receive pursuant to the terms, conditions, and prices set forth in the Arvin Piggyback Bid #2018-19-001, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" (the "Proposal").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Board makes the following findings:

- Section 1. <u>Determination of Recitals</u>. All of the recitals set forth above are true and correct, and the District's Board so finds and determines.
- Section 2. Determination of Purchase Through Arvin Piggyback Contract. The District's Board hereby finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the District to authorize procurement of the Goods and Services in accordance with Chapter 2 (commencing with Section 10290) and Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 12100) of the Public Contract Code, without competitive bidding through the Arvin Piggyback Contract.
- Section 3. Delegation of Authority. That the District's Board hereby approves the delegation of authority and appoints its Assistant Superintendent, Business & Support Services, who is hereby authorized and directed, pursuant to a majority of the vote of the District's Board and Education Code section 17604 and similar statutes, to execute, deliver or otherwise negotiate contracts, requisitions, or purchase orders, including the Proposal, with Sierra School Equipment pursuant to the Arvin

Piggyback Bid #2018-19-001 for the Goods and Services and to otherwise carry out the intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. <u>Effective Date</u>. This resolution shall be effective as of date of its adoption until otherwise rescinded by the District's Board.
