BACKGROUND INFORMATION: Board approval is required when students travel out of the state on school activities.

CURRENT CONSIDERATIONS: The Burroughs High School Track & Field team will travel to Henderson, NV to participate in the Silver State Invitational on March 21-23, 2019.
