

Draft 2024-2027 Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) Actions



New Actions for Consideration:

Dual Enrollment. Provide opportunities for students to engage in articulated and dual enrollment courses through Cerro Coso Community College.

College and Career Readiness. Develop the district's Portrait of a Graduate to define the skills and competencies of graduates in preparation for college and the workforce.

College Readiness Courses. Provide and expand access for students to complete college readiness courses (A-G or CSU/UC requirements), including Advanced Placement (AP) courses. (Prof. dev., AP exam fees, etc.)

Social-Emotional Learning. Implement evidence-based student engagement and social-emotional learning programs (Second-Step, Panorama, Capturing Kids Hearts)

Literacy. Provide programs and professional development that lead to effective, standards-aligned instruction and improve instruction in literacy across all subject areas.

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1. **Academic Program:** Provide a rigorous academic program that supports opportunities and preparedness for all students to explore and pursue their aspirations.

1.	Continue TK-8 counseling services
2.	Support student achievement data analysis software/programs
3.	Continue secondary academic intervention support
4.	Support Math English Technology Skills (METS) Course (BHS) for at-risk freshman
5.	Provide English Learner Coordination/supplemental support
6.	Provide ALAS middle school (supplemental EL support)
7.	Provide Supplemental English Language Development support (BHS)
8.	Provide High School Credit Recovery Programs Including Summer School
9.	Continue English Learner Teacher for High School Credit Recovery Programs
10.	Continue Coordinator of student services and staff (75%)
11.	Continue Secondary Student Support Center teachers
12.	Continue elementary Positive Behavior Intervention and Support (PBIS) stipends

1.	Continue two-way school-to-home communication programs
